Teacher's Discussion

When someone dies, their soul will leave their body immediately and go to Jesus to be judged. There are three destinations for our soul at death. Heaven, *Purgatory*, and Hell. The souls who have obeyed God's rules will go to Heaven. All souls in Heaven are called *saints*.

All souls who loved God, but had not completely obeyed Him, will go to Purgatory until they are ready to meet Jesus face to face.

Those souls who have continually disobeyed God will go to Hell, where they will never see Jesus.

Present Faith & Life 1st Grade Lesson #28

Classroom Activities

Prepare three boxes with covers that have large slits.

- One beautifully decorated in white and gold
- One decorated in a progressive black (small amount) to white and gold
- One totally black

Using half sheets of standard white paper

- 1/2 of children make pictures of 10 good actions (Heaven)
- 1/4 of children make pictures of 3 good actions, 7 bad actions (Hell)
- 1/4 of children make pictures of 5 good actions, 5 bad actions (Purgatory)

Staple books together.

Shuffle the books and hand them out to the children.

"All good" books are placed in the white box

"Half good/half bad" books are placed in black to white box..

"Mostly bad" books are placed in the black box.

1st and 2nd Grade

This is a good place to stress that Jesus gave us Confession to allow even those souls who had more bad deeds can remove them by going to confession.

Remove the books from the black box.

Children can draw a picture of a priest in a confessional.

Insert the Confession picture into the black box books,

Place books in the Heaven box.

Since we do not know the condition of anyone's soul when they die, a box can be covered with pictures of people the children know who have died. This box can be called a "Hopefully Saints" box. A slit in the top of the box will allow children to put slips of paper into it representing each time they pray for a person who might be in Purgatory.
