Teacher's Discussion

Tell the story of Noah. (Read Bible passage.)
Genesis 6:9-12, 7:1-6, 8:12, 9:1-3, 9:8-15

If God asked the class to build a fireproof room big enough for all of them, their families and two animals of every kind, what would be the reaction of everyone else in their community?

- They wouldn't believe God spoke to the children
- They would laugh at the children

Explain that Noah had great faith and trust in God. We too, must have faith and trust in God.

God made a promise to man never to flood the earth again. A firm promise between God and man is call a *covenant*.

Ask the children if they have ever made a promise and then broken it.

- God NEVER breaks His promises Every time there is a rainbow, remember God's promise, covenant, with His people.

Classroom Activity

Children can make a rainbow to demonstrate God's covenant with His people.

Teacher's Discussion

God selected a group of people to be the *Chosen People* who would continue His plan for our *salvation*. (Read the Bible passage.)
Genesis 22:1-14

God tested Abraham. Talk about tests that God gives us through parents, teachers, friends etc.; right vs. wrong choices.

Mom and Dad test us to see if we are ready for more responsibility as we grow up; crossing the street, riding a bike, doing chores, schoolwork etc.

God asked Abraham to *sacrifice* his son, Issac. God was pleased that Abraham was willing to make the sacrifice. What sacrifices do we make in our lives?

God was pleased with Abraham and is pleased with us when we make the right choices.
